SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

ROUND TWO - PHILLIP ISLAND

To be read in conjunction with the 2019 CAMS Victorian State Circuit Racing Championship Series Regulations, available from the Organisers.

1. EVENT DESCRIPTION AND AUTHORITY

The Event will be a **Victorian State Championship Race Meeting**, conducted at the Phillip Island Grand Prix Circuit over a lap distance of 4.45km in an anti-clockwise direction on 4th May and 5th May 2019, held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, National Competition Rules of Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (CAMS), The Race Meeting Standing Regulations, the 2019 CAMS Victorian State Circuit Racing Championship Series Regulations, the Phillip Island Grand Prix Circuit Standing Race Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations or instructions Issued for the Meeting. This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S, CAMS Safety 1st and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au. CAMS Permit Number **319/0505/03**.

5. ENTRIES

- 5.1 Entries open on publication of these Regulations and close on 25th April 2019.
- 5.2 Each Competitor must hold a CAMS Competition Licence unless they comply with (a) or (b) below. Each Driver must hold a minimum of a CAMS Provisional Clubman Circuit competition or;

(a) hold a MotorSport New Zealand competition licence and Tasman Visa valid for the Event; or

(b) hold a minimum of the highest grade National Licence issued by a foreign ASN together with an authorisation issued by that ASN for the Event; each such Driver and Competitor:

(i) shall be ineligible to score points in any Championship/Cup/Series/Trophy/etc connected with the Event; and

(ii) must receive an authorisation to compete from CAMS prior to the Event;

- 5.3 Entries will be accepted in order of receipt, until the track density for each category has been reached. The maximum number of entries will be 400.
- 5.4 The Organiser confirms that the circuit to be used for this Event holds the necessary CAMS National Track licence for each of the Events nominated in these Supplementary Regulations. Entries open on publication of these Regulations and close on 25th April 2019.
- 5.5 The preferred method of entry for this event will be via the CAMS online system www.meecamsau.com. The Entry Fee is \$415.00 (GST inclusive) for entries received prior to 11th April 2019 * \$446.00 thereafter until close on 25th April 2019. *The full entry fee must be received before your entry can be considered as accepted.*
- 5.6 The Organisers reserve the right to accept or reject any entry without assigning a reason (NCR 83).

6. INVITED CATEGORIES

Races will be run for cars complying with the Regulations for the following categories:-

Sports Sedans, Improved Production, Sports Cars (Group 2Bi, 2Bii, 2Biii & 2F & (including invited 2A FIA GT3 & GT4 (*as per Appendix A*) & 5th category Sa, Sb, Sc & Group T), Formula Vee, Formula Ford 1600, Formula Ford, Porsche 944 Sports Cars, MGs (including invited British Sports Cars), BMW E30, HQ Holdens, Group N Historic Touring Cars, Saloon Cars and Circuit Excels.

7. SCRUTINY

- 7.1. Targeted Scrutiny procedures will be applied at this Meeting.
- 7.2. Competitors must present their appropriate CAMS Licence Card, CAMS Licence Passbook, CAMS affiliated car club membership, and vehicle logbook at Document Checking/Scrutiny.
- 7.3. All Driver apparel shall be in accordance with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

8. GENERAL

- 8.1. Protests, if any, must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the NCR.
- 8.2. The Promoter reserves the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the Event in accordance with NCR 59.
- 8.3. Fuel shall be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.
- 8.4. Judges of Fact will be named in the Official Program.

9. AWARDS

Points will be awarded toward the relevant CAMS Victorian Championship/Series for each Support Race and Main Race for the relevant category, in accordance with the CAMS 2019 VSCRC Series Regulations. Awards for each race will consist of certificates supplied by the Victorian State Race Series Inc.

10. ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

11. INSURANCE

Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the Event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at www.cams.com.au.
